The importance of this trial as a legal precedent was that the victim as able to identify the rapists after undergoing hypnosis sessions for retrograde amnesia with me. This testimony which was allowed in court set a major precedent for Hawaii courts. A description of this case and my work in it was reported in the February, 1984 issue of *Psychology Today*, the International Medical Newsletter 1983, the *Honolulu Star Bulletin* and *Honolulu Advertiser*, in Nov. and Dec. 1982.
