Pre-Enrolled Course: You will be pre-enrolled in either Critical Thinking and Writing (CTW) 1 and 2, Cultures and Ideas (C&I) 1 and 2, or Religion and Theology (RTC) 1 courses. If you enrolled in either the CTW or C&I sequence, you will also be pre-enrolled in the second part of the sequence in either winter or spring. This minimizes scheduling conflicts, ensures progress toward graduation, and allows you to focus on available choices when you register for your remaining fall quarter courses.

*Math Requirement:

Math 9 and 9L, Math 30 and 31 are offered every quarter. Most business students take the MATH 30/31 sequence. Business students desiring to take mathematics beyond the two required courses of calculus should take MATH 11/12 instead in order to satisfy the prerequisites to more advanced mathematics courses. We also recommend students who wish to take Math 11/12 in order to satisfy prerequisites pursuing a major or minor in engineering or sciences.
