

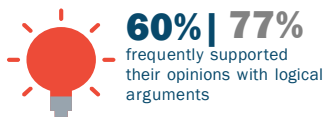

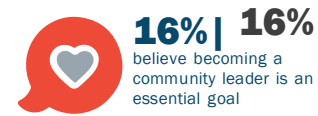
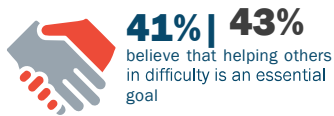

Members of the 2019 freshman class strive for academic success, are concerned with the global environment, and have weighed in on issues impacting the sociopolitical climate.

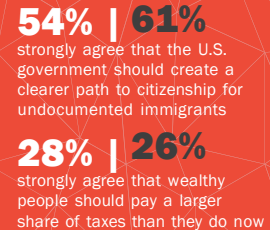
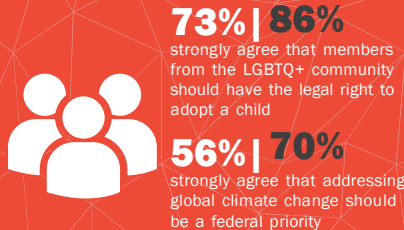
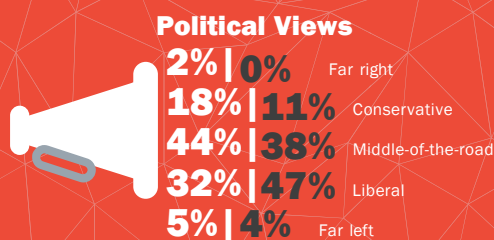
In high school, they engaged in behaviors that serve as the foundation for lifelong learning.



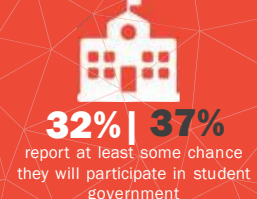
Though they are focused on accomplishing their goals, they also demonstrate their interest in impacting others along the way.



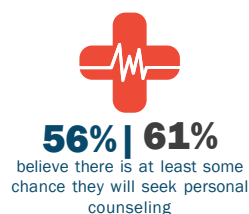
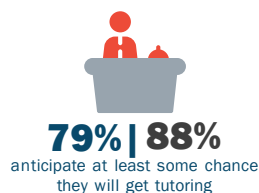
Students' views on the sociopolitical climate are of great importance...
