*Sabbatical Taken Over More Than One Year: This option is not routinely granted. The Faculty Handbook (3.7.7.1) states: "Sabbatical leaves should be taken during a single academic year....Exceptions may be permitted in special cases with the approval of the chair, dean, and Provost. To be considered for a sabbatical extending over more than a single academic year, the candidate must present a strong rationale for why this is necessary, and the Provost must be assured that the arrangement would not place undue burdens on students or colleagues."
