

University Award for Recent Achievement in Scholarship

The University Award for Recent Achievement in Scholarship recognizes a faculty member whose scholarly or creative work over the previous five years represents a major contribution to a field of knowledge or to the arts. The nominee must be a tenured faculty member or senior lecturer. Any Santa Clara University faculty member may nominate a colleague at SCU for the award. The nominee must not have previously won this award ([please see the list of previous awardees here](#)), and no self-nominations will be considered.

Once nominated, a faculty member stays in the pool of candidates under active consideration for two years and may be nominated again any number of times. The deadline for nominations is Monday, April 22, 2024.

This year, there will be no option to upload supplemental materials or recommendation letters. Prompts with essay boxes are provided. Keep in mind that nominating faculty members play a vital role in helping the committee to contextualize and understand the impact of the nominee's scholarship or creative work. Once a faculty member is nominated, the Office of Research will contact the nominee directly to obtain a current CV.
