


## PILOT'S RESULTS

(DISHWARE IN SWIG COLLECTED OVER 3 WEEKS)




# PILOT RESULTS

(MONEY PROJECTED TO BE SAVED OVER ONE YEAR ON CAMPUS)




#### **TRENDS**

➤ Ceramic flat plates and large plastic bowls biggest \$ amount lost but only ~½ as many lost as utensils

### **TRENDS**

➤ Huge \$ of items lost but rate of build up in pilot indicates the problem lies elsewhere

## RECOMMENDATIONS

- Switch to an Eco-tray Program
- Force Students to eat in Benson, do not give them a to-go option
- Implement a security system where students are prevented from taking the plates
