Silhouette Cameo Cutting Tool Overview

Overview of Tool Usage:

Cameo is a computer controlled cutting tool for cutting fabric, paper and thin plastics such as vinyl. It also has the capabilities of computer controlled drawing with different tooling.

Personal Protective Equipment:

- o Safety Glasses
- Long hair tied back, no loose clothing/jewelry, long sleeves must be rolled up past your elbows and out of the way

Parts to Identify:

- o Power Cord
- o USB Cord
- o Blades/Pens
- o Blade Depth Adjuster/Ratchet Cap
- o Blade Lock Lever
- o Rollers
- o Roller Release Lever

Setting Up:

- o Setting up Cameo
 - o Plug Cameo into power and USB port
 - o Choose blade (general blade, fabric blade or pen)
 - o Look up blade setting for selected media and turn blade to that setting
 - o Load blade or pen and lock
 - o Set roller distance for media
- o Power on Cameo
 - o Power on
 - o Prep media on cutting mat if needed
 - When ready select load cutting mat or media then press "enter on key pad of Cameo
 - o If needed you can do small adjustments by raiding rollers then lowering after adjustment has been made
- o Using Silhouette software
 - o Set up project in Silhouette software
 - o When ready select "Send to Silhouette"
 - o Select "Change Settings?"
 - o Choose Media, Speed, Thickness, Blade...ect
 - o Select "Cut"



- o Finishing Project
 - o Select "Unload" on Cameo to remove media
 - o Remove blade and set blade depth to zero
 - o Power off
 - o Unplug and Store Cameo
- O When you don't know or aren't sure, ask!

Tips:

- o Can import in dxf, png, jpeg, bmp, gif, and tiff.
- When setting up Cameo, make sure there is enough room in front and behind of Cameo to run your material through.

Specifications:

Blade Setting	Material
1	Thin materials such as vinyl and smooth heat transfer material
2-3	Medium-weight materials such as paper, cardstock, and flocked heat transfer material
4-6	Thicker materials such as textured cardstock and pattern papers
7-10	Thick materials such as canvas

Cuts up to 12-inch wide and 10-feet long material

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
