## GRADUATE & LAW HOUSING CLOSING CHECK LIST — SPRING 2025

Santa Clara Law residents must move out by 9:00pm on Saturday, May 31, 2025.

Graduate Program residents must move out by 9:00pm on Monday, June 30, 2025.

Residents are expected to complete the following checkout procedures before leaving for the year. Failure to complete any of the procedures below may result in assessment of charges or improper checkout fines.
