### It's time to Get Enrolled!

When do I enroll in classes?

- Students attending on-campus Orientation in July will be enrolling in classes during their Orientation session.
- Students who are attending their on-campus Orientation in September will have their academic advising and course enrollment sessions online in July or August.
- •• Watch your email for specific details and schedules for your on-campus Orientation session and/or your online academic advising and course enrollment session.

#### Pro Tips:

- Complete the required <u>Workday Onboarding steps</u> (required for course enrollment), <u>Calculus</u>
   <u>Readiness Exam</u>, and the <u>Language Placement processes</u> prior to your academic advising and course enrollment session.
- Be open to new opportunities! We distribute available seats in certain first year courses across all course enrollment sessions so everyone has the same opportunity to enroll. You'll also find many courses available to first year students to meet our <a href="Core Curriculum requirements">Core Curriculum requirements</a>.
- If you are seeking accommodations for documented disabilities, begin the registration process with the
   Office of Accessible Education (OAE) right away to avoid a long wait time for review at the start of the
   fall quarter.

## Est up your ACCESS Credential by July 25, 2025

The ACCESS mobile credential is Santa Clara University's official campus ID, door key, library card, and recreation center card. The credential is also used for campus dining plans, flex plans, and printing.

- Check your SCU email account for a message from ACCESS@scu.edu with the subject "Welcome to SCU". This communication from our ACCESS office provides all the details you need to upload your photo and request your account set up.
  - Ocheck your SCU email account (and spam folder!) for an email from "Salutations from Online Photo". This message contains the personalized link to upload your photo into our system. Your photo can only be submitted using the personalized link.
  - Note that Duo authentication and your SCU student ID number are required to set up your digital ACCESS credential after your image has been approved.

## Looking Ahead: Key Dates and Deadlines

Please plan now so you can meet these deadlines.

- July 11: Deadline to submit final high school transcripts to the Office of Undergraduate Admission. You can verify that SCU has received your final HS transcript in your application status portal.
- July 24: Deadline to accept financial aid/student loans and complete any outstanding financial Action Items in <u>Workday</u>
- July 25: Deadline to set up your ACCESS credential
- August 1: Medical history form is due
- August 1: <u>Vaccination record</u> is due
- August 1: Fall tuition bill is available in Workday
- August 15: Recommended date for filing a <u>health insurance waiver</u> (Available 5 days after enrolling in 6+ units)
- August 21: <u>Fall payment</u> is due
