• Claim your SCU account. Do this right away, as you'll need this access to our single sign-on (SSO) system for subsequent steps! On or after May 13, you can activate your account following these instructions.

- Students in <u>majors that require Calculus</u> should make plans to complete the <u>Calculus Readiness Exam</u> (CRE) before the **June 15 priority deadline**.
- You can learn 9 different languages at SCU! Plan now so you can complete the <u>language placement</u> <u>process</u> (if needed) before the <u>June 29 priority deadline</u>.
