Torientation Schedule

For those attending an on-campus Orientation session in July, the <u>preliminary schedule</u> is now available and includes important information on what to bring.

Important Reminders:

- Academic advising and course enrollment are part of the schedule for the on-campus Orientation sessions in July (Sessions 1-5).
- Students signed up for Orientation **Session 6** will have an online academic advising and course enrollment session on **July 28**.
 - o Specific schedule information and Zoom links will be sent in mid-July.

- Students signed up for Orientation **Session** 7 will have an online academic advising and course enrollment session on **July 29**.
 - Specific schedule information and Zoom links will be sent in mid-July.
- Orientation Session 6 and Session 7 participants will have their on-campus component in September.

■ Before Academic Advising and Course Enrollment in July

To prepare for your academic advising and course enrollment session, be sure you have completed the <u>Get</u> <u>Enrolled steps</u> below:

- <u>Technology set-up</u>, including claiming your SCU account to access your MySCU Portal, setting up Duo 2-Factor Authentication, and completing the Workday onboarding steps.
- Students in <u>majors that require calculus</u> must complete the <u>Calculus Readiness Exam</u> to enroll in a math course in the fall. Here is our recommendation if you are <u>waiting on AP test scores</u>.
- Students must complete the <u>language placement</u> process to enroll in language courses. You can learn more about language <u>proficiency requirements based on your major</u>.
- For transfer credit evaluation, submit official college transcripts through your SCU Application Status Portal or to appstatus@scu.edu.

Immersion and Excursion Trips

Are you interested in getting to know other incoming students before classes begin? We have two exciting opportunities for you to consider: immersion trips and excursion trips! <u>Click to learn more</u>.

Immersion Trips are sponsored by the Ignatian Center. The deadline to apply is July 20, 2025.

- At Santa Clara, <u>immersions</u> are transformative learning experiences where students engage directly with communities to recognize unjust suffering, stand in solidarity, build relationships, and reflect on their experiences.
- The <u>First Year Immersion trip</u> is a five-day program that engages new students to learn about the people and organizations who are working hard to make the Bay Area a better place. This year's themes are civic engagement for mental health and civic engagement for housing equity.

Excursion Trips are sponsored by SCU's <u>Into the Wild</u> outdoor wilderness student organization. The deadline to apply for the excursions <u>lottery</u> is July 28, 2025.

• You can choose from <u>8 different camping or backpacking trips</u>, ranging from beginner to advanced skill levels. There is no cost to attend, and gear is available to rent if needed.

Note that <u>some students are not eligible to participate</u> in these trips due to other commitments at the same time:

• Students who signed up for **Orientation Session 6 or Session 7 (in September)** are not eligible, as they will be participating in required Orientation sessions.

- International students are not eligible, as they will be participating in the International Student Welcome.
- LEAD students are not eligible, as they will be participating in LEAD Week activities.
