Student Health Forms Due August 1

As part of Santa Clara's care for the whole person, we have campus resources for student <u>health</u>, <u>counseling</u>, <u>and well-being</u>. One important onboarding step is providing basic medical information and immunization records for our <u>student medical services office</u>.

- New students are required to complete a **basic medical information form** and provide **immunization information** in the <u>My Student Health Portal</u> accessible through the <u>MySCU Portal</u>.
- You can learn more about the immunization requirements for all incoming students.
- The deadline for completing the health form and providing immunization information is **August 1**. Failure to meet this deadline will result in a hold being placed on your registration which will prevent

Student Money Matters

There are a number of financial matters to understand as you begin your college journey. Here are a few campusspecific things to help you get started:

- <u>Financial responsibility</u> Students are responsible for all charges billed to their account and for knowing deadlines for payment, regardless of who pays the bill. Information regarding deadlines and policies is available online, and staff in the One Stop office can answer questions you have (Follow them on IG: @scu_onestop). You can also refer to the letter mailed to your home address in early July.
 - The fall bill is available August 1; The <u>payment</u> deadline is <u>August 21</u>. Instructions are available to <u>set</u> up an authorized payer in Workday for your account.
 - Be sure to accept your Financial Aid in Workday by <u>July 24</u> so it can be properly reflected on your August 1 billing statement.
- Dining plan options Learn how dining plan points work and where you can use them on and off campus throughout the academic year.
 - o Dining points work on a declining balance system; 1 point = \$1. Dining Services posts a points pacing chart to help you plan your dining points use through each quarter.
 - o Read the <u>FAQs</u> to understand what happens to unused dining points at the end of the quarter.
 - Note that the deadline for changes to the fall quarter meal plan is <u>August 4</u>. You can request a change through the housing portal.
- Textbooks can be expensive! As you prepare for fall classes, check out our <u>SCU Campus Store</u> for new and used textbooks, as well as digital books and textbook rental options, too.

The ACCESS mobile credential is Santa Clara University's official campus ID, door key, library card, and recreation center card. The credential is also used for campus dining plans, flex plans, and printing.

Looking Ahead: Key Dates and Deadlines

There are lots of important deadlines coming soon - we recommend you start working on them now!

- July 24: Deadline to accept financial aid/student loans and complete any outstanding financial Action Items in Workday
- July 25: Deadline to set up your ACCESS credential
- August 1: Medical history form is due
- August 1: Vaccination record is due
- August 1: Fall tuition bill is available in Workday
- August 15: Recommended date for filing a <u>health insurance waiver</u> (Available 5 days after enrolling in 6+ units)
- August 21: <u>Fall payment</u> is due
